School Allocation

Please let a member of staff know what school your child has been allocated.

This is so we can liaise with the school to make the transition from nursery as easy as possible.

If you have any concerns regarding your child moving to school please speak to a senior member of staff.

Mobile Phones

Please can we remind everyone not to use their mobile phones within nursery.

All calls need to be taken outside the building.



Spare Clothes

If we send your child home in nursery spare clothes (including socks and pants) please could they be returned to us.

We only have a limited amount of spare clothes etc so please send them back to nursery as soon as you can.

Medication

Please remember that if your child has been prescribed medication they cannot come into nursery for the first 24 hours.

This is to make sure they do not have a reaction to the medication.

Illness

If we have contact you to collect your child due to them being unwell a member of staff will give you a note advising when they would be able to return to nursery.

This is to reduce to spread of infection and ensure a healthy environment.

Please remember to let us know if you have moved house, changed your mobile number or work number so we have the correct contact details should we need to contact you while your child is at nursery.

What we will be doing in April

Babies

Babies will be doing lots of Easter activities, decorating egg pictures and making Easter cards

Tweenies

The Tweenies will be taking part in the Easter Bonnet competition and doing lots of activities including creative and an Easter egg hunt

Toddlers

The Toddler room will be getting messy and creative as they take part in all the Easter activities

Large Toddlers
