All other schools out of the local area we will liaise with and any planned visits to the nursery by teachers will be shared with parents and arranged at a time their child is in nursery.

## Slapped Cheek

If your child has been diagnosed with Slapped Cheek please inform the nursery at your earliest convenience as we have a child in nursery that could possibly be effected by the condition

## Medication

Please remember that if your child has been prescribed medication they cannot come into nursery for the first 24 hours.

This is to make sure they do not have a reaction to the medication.



## Illness

If we have contact you to collect your child due to them being unwell a member of staff will give you a note advising when they would be able to return to nursery.

This is to reduce to spread of infection and ensure a healthy environment.

## What we will be doing in May

### Babies

The theme in Babies will be  
'We're going on a Bear Hunt'

The babies will be making pictures for a display  
and exploring different 'Bear Hunt' sensory trays

### Tweenies

The children will be spending more time outdoors  
now the weather is warming up. They will be  
taking part in running games, action games and  
dancing. Tweenies will be exploring water and the  
different things they can do with it.

### Toddlers

The children will be creating a builders yard in the  
role play area

### Large Toddlers

Toddlers will be exploring the Forest School area

The children will be doing flower printing and  
plating some seeds
