Coronavirus

We would like to thank our parents for your continued support and positive comments during this difficult time, it is very much appreciated.

At present nursery will remain open unless any guidelines change.

All parents and visitors to nursery must continue to wear face masks, use the hand sanitiser and observe social distancing while you are dropping off or collecting.

If your child develops any symptom at nursery or has a temperature that is over 37.8 we will contact you to collect them.

You will then need to self isolate for 10 days and arrange for your child to be tested. Your child can return to nursery if the test is negative, however your child still needs to be 48 hours clear of any symptoms before returning.

Communicating with Nursery

If you are waiting for a Coronavirus test result for anyone within your household including children or have any symptoms you have a duty of care to inform the nursery.



Dropping off and collection

- In a morning please could we ask parents to wait in their cars until 7.30am and not to gather in the reception area as this is a small space and difficult to social distance.
- We still need to keep the amount of people coming into nursery to a minimum. Therefore we are continuing to ask parents that only one person drops off or collects.
- Please don't bring older siblings into nursery if possible, however we realise that sometimes parents will have siblings with them so if this is the case bring them into nursery, please do not leave them in the car alone.



Car Seats

It has been reported to us that a child has been seen sitting in the front of a car on an adults lap coming into the nursery car park.
