New Children

Medication

Please do not leave any medication in your child's bag. If your child has been prescribed medication from your GP it will need to be given to a member of staff and a form completed. Children can only return to nursery after 24 hours of the first dose being given.

Car Seats

We have been informed on a couple of occasions that children have been seen coming to nursery and leaving nursery not strapped into an appropriate car seat.

To make it safer for children travelling in a vehicle the law was changed a couple of years ago.

Calpol

Please do not leave Calpol in your child's nursery bag.

If your child has a temperature you will be contacted for you to give permission for us to administer one dose of Calpol which is provided by nursery.

Slapped Cheek

If your child has been diagnosed with Slapped Cheek please inform the nursery at your earliest convenience. We have a child in nursery that can be affected by the condition

Please remember that if your child has been prescribed medication they cannot come into nursery for the first 24 hours.

This is to make sure they do not have a reaction to the medication.

If we have contact you to collect your child due to them being unwell a member of staff will give you a note advising when they would be able to return to nursery.

This is to reduce to spread of infection and ensure a healthy environment.
