### Coronavirus

Following our letter sent out in July we would just like to highlight the recent changes made by the Government

#### From 19<sup>th</sup> July

##### Face Masks

These are not mandatory but we are still asking parents to wear continue to wear them whilst in nursery, especially as we have now had two cases. If you do not wish to wear a face mask we understand and you will still be able to enter nursery.

##### Social distancing

These restrictions have been lifted but please be mindful and respectful of other parents and staff and social distance where possible.

##### Dropping off and Collecting

We will still be requesting just one parent drops off and collects.

##### Bubbles

We will be continuing with our bubbles at nursery due to the rising cases in Telford and Wrekin as this is safer for the children, parents and staff.

##### Hand Sanitiser

This will still be available to everyone and we encourage you to continue sanitising your hands.

#### From 16<sup>th</sup> August

##### Isolating

Children under 18 year of age will no longer need to self isolate if they have been in close contact with a positive case but will be advised to take a PCR test.

### Communicating with us

It is really important that you advise us if anybody different is collecting your child. If you are unable to call please email the information to us. This saves us trying to get hold of parents at the end of the day to clarify that the person that has arrived at nursery is authorised to collect on your behalf.

## Dropping off and collection

- In a morning please could we ask parents to wait in their cars until 7.30am and not to gather in the reception area as this is a small space and difficult to social distance.
- We still need to keep the amount of people coming into nursery to a minimum. Therefore we are continuing to ask parents that only one person drops off or collects.
- Please don't bring older siblings into nursery if possible, however we realise that sometimes parents will have siblings with them so if this is the case bring them into nursery, please do not leave them in the car alone.
- **Please do not stand for long periods of time in your child's room. If you have lots of information or questions please send an email and we will pass this to the staff.**
- **Please do not stand in the nursery corridors chatting to other parents. We are trying to reduce the amount of time parents are spending in nursery and it also makes it difficult for other parents to pass and socially distance if they are wishing to.**
